Notice

In connection with the conduct of the online examination of M. Sc. (Electronics) programme offered at the Department, the following instructions are notified:

- 1) Respective course teacher shall serve as examiner for the conduct of online examination who shall conduct the examination as per the date sheet notified by the Department. Further, there shall be a nominee of the Head of the Department, who shall monitor and ensure smooth conduct of online examination. The nominee shall be given full access to the Google Classroom and other platforms used for the conduct of the examination by the respective examiner.
- 2) All awards and proofs whatsoever shall be forwarded by the concerned examiner through the nominee to the Head of the Department immediately after the conduct of the online examination of each course.
- 3) Email addresses of all the examinees shall be verified by the examiner before the conduct of the examination.
- 4) Examination shall be held in 03 parts with the following distribution:
 - a) **Part 1 (MCQ):** 8 x Number of Theory credits (excluding laboratory credits) multiple choice questions (MCQs), having 1 mark each to be completed in (1.5 x Number of MCQs) minutes including its submission (unless explicitly mentioned for a particular course). This shall be held through Google Forms in Google Classroom.
 - b) **Part 2 (Short Answer):** 1 x Number of Theory credits (excluding laboratory credits) short answer questions each having 6 marks, to be completed in (9 x Number of short answer questions) minutes including its submission. This part shall also be held through Google Classroom.
 - c) **Part 3 (Viva-Voce):** Viva-voce of each student shall be held for a minimum duration of 5 minutes. This part shall carry a weightage of 30% of total marks in theory (excluding laboratory marks). The examiner shall preferably use Zoom Meeting for this part.
- 5) Standard Operating Procedures in accordance to University of Kashmir and Government shall be followed during the conduct of the online examination.
